

Lecturers qualify as assessors

During July of this year Petra College lecturers were trained as assessors - officially registered evaluators.

This was another step in the process, which will enable us to issue internationally recognised qualifications to our students. SAQA requires that students be evaluated by registered evaluators (assessors) before their qualifications are officially recognised.

After completion of the training each lecturer had to compile a portfolio of proof of competency. This process is now almost completed and the College should start the new year with at least fifteen registered assessors.



During the assessor-training, facilitated by Tom Ventouris of People Management and Development Services not only local lecturers were trained but also those from Petra College, Western-Cape as well as two field lecturers.
